Version 6 Database


Like other components in the Pongrass Newspaper System, News Editor fully integrates with the V6 Newspaper Database.

technologies to reduce communication overheads across the network. Typical broadband users will notice no difference between remote and newsroom response times.

Advanced User Interface

A tree view displaying all newsroom desks across the enterprise is supported. User desktop settings can be extremely customized for maximum productivity, and these settings are held in the user’s login preference. News Editor styles integrate with Pongrass InDesign Plug-in.

Spell Check/Thesaurus

Along with the server based spell-check/thesaurus, News Editor enables browser based spell-check-as-you-type facility by downloading custom dictionaries.

Picture Integration

Pictures can be attached to the article, along with captions and notes with the click of a button. Uploads take place in the background, useful when available Internet

connections are challenged.

Layout Aware

With the appropriate user security login, editors can allocate stories, pictures and story elements directly to the page. Previewing capabilities allow the user to check other page elements, ads and stories already attached to the page in real time.

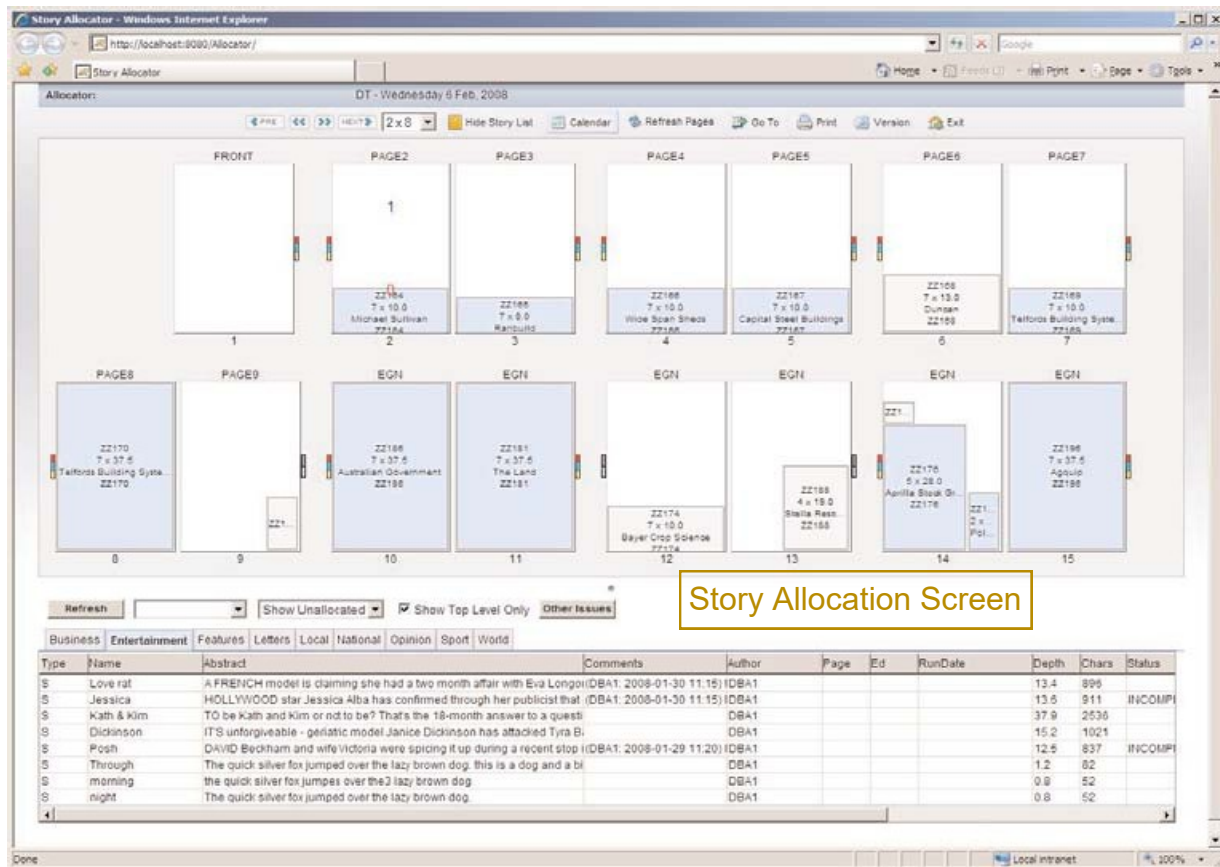

The Editorial Tracking System for InDesign

DESCRIPTION

Tracking and Sharing

The Pongrass Editorial Layout System is a suite of programs that allows multiple workstations to collaborate in the makeup of finished newspaper and magazine pages, ready to output to PDF or direct to image setter. The heart of the system is the SQL compliant Editorial Database, tracking and controlling all aspects of the production process. Every element of the page production process, including graphics, stories, pictures, ad and standing elements are registered in the database; ready for use in the composition process. InDesign is connected directly to the database al-

lowing the quick generation of pages for an edition. Folios and other standing elements are placed automatically while ads and ad rules are placed according to the layout held in the database.

Heart of the System

At the heart of the system lies the Pongrass Newspaper database. Database support includes the Sybase ASA database engine. The Editorial database is a true relational database supporting industry standard SQL. Tracking multiple story versions, ads, standing elements, multiple editions, publications and zones over an extended period of time is achieved with high performance on standard file server hardware.

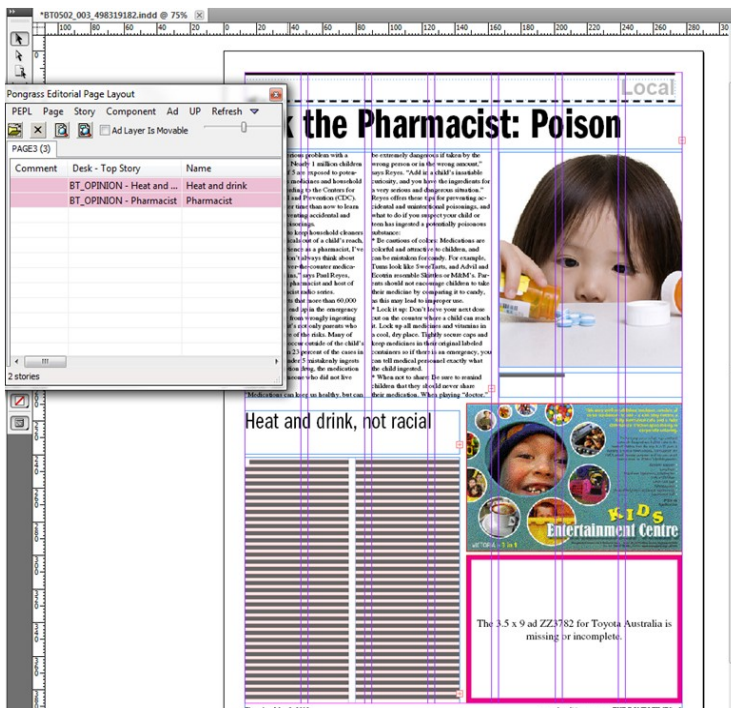
Internet Publishing

The database was designed with content repurposing in mind, and XML data transfer lies at the heart of the editorial web server publishing process. Pongrass WebAd Server interfaces directly with the database to allow real-time internet publishing.

The Ad Stack

PEPL™ is the application that connects InDesign to the

database. PEPL loads all the ads for an issue in a single operation. Ads can be dummied before they are produced, and on final production will automatically appear on the correct page, printable and fully previewed. Late ads and moved ads are handled automatically.

Photographs and Graphics

All elements to be used in the system are registered in the database. Extracted information such as Captions, Headline, Keywords and Category are applied to the database along with thumbnail and other preview data during the registration process. Story allocator allows browsed photos to be dragged and dropped on to pages.

Housekeeping

The tedium of housekeeping is at an end. Purging and archiving are now background processes controlled from the database.

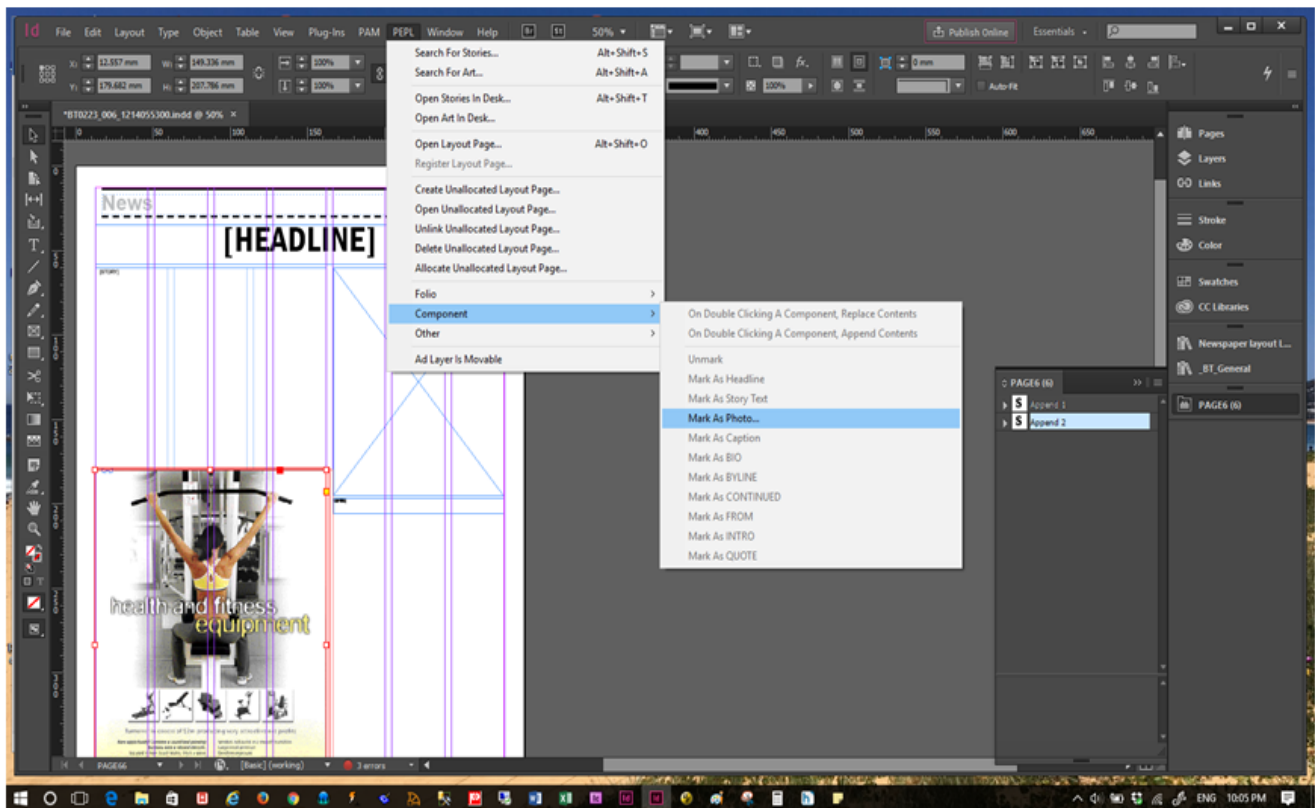

Fast Search

You can search on publication, edition, date run, key word, author etc. Full indexed text search is available on editorial content.

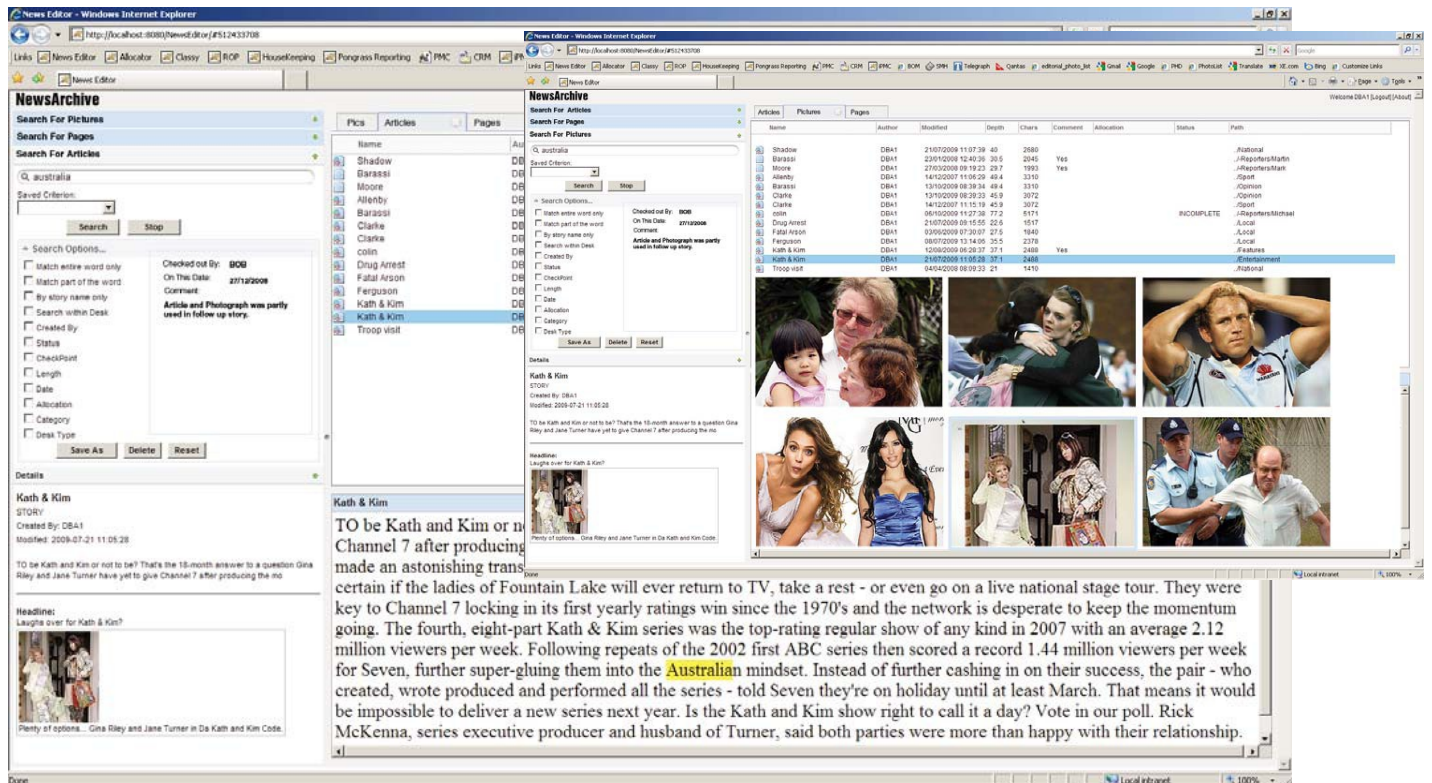
Automatic Archiving

After an edition has been paginated and marked for archiving, an export to the archive database is scheduled. Pictures, text and other story elements

are exported, and registered in the archive. PDF pages are registered and linked to archived page elements. The full text index is generated as part of the archiving process.

Picture Archive

All pictures associated with a story are stored along with crop data from the Pongrass Editorial System. Picture browsing is quick and efficient using jpeg previews from the archive. Pictures can be found via story links or searches on IPTC data.


